


Manthana has given an opportunity for trainee teachers to acquire the above mentioned intellectual competencies practically.



The problem with women's cricket in India

Walk into any school in India and you will see a group of boys playing cricket, organized or not, in the playground. Have you ever seen girls playing instead? My guess is no. It's not played by school girls, so where will the talent feed for under-19 and state cricket come from?

Here lies the starting point for any story about Indian Women's Cricket.

Women's Cricket has travelled a long distance in the country from its beginning under women's cricket Association of India. The game is run by the BCCI these days and that has led to many benefits, but there are still areas in which the WCAI, women cricketers will tell you, did a better job.

For women's cricket to develop and grow, the BCCI and state associations must increase participation at the grassroot levels. I played state cricket for karnataka and i can tell you that for women's cricket, the grassroots is tough terrain.

Most boys begin playing cricket, unofficially or officially, when they are ten or eleven years old. They have the opportunity to play for their school or district, and soon enough get the chance to represent the state. At the school level, girls in India have practically no opportunity to play cricket.

Women's Cricket in the country is simply divided into two categories, Under-19 and seniors. There are no school or club matches that help selectors pick at the Under-19 level, so a player only gets to play matches if she is considered good enough to be selected in the state team. Most girls who graduate from Under-19 make it to the senior team, but those who don't usually give up the

This lack of opportunity is the biggest concern for women's cricket. If girls aren't given the chance to play more matches, our standards will never rise, the truth is that many academics don't accommodate girls, and therefore there are very few places where girls can be coached.

A short history of the Olympics

Athletes completed in the first olympic games in Greece almost three thousand years ago in 776 BC. Every four years, people from greek city states (and later the Roman empire) travelled to a place called olympia to watch the games, which continued until 393 AD. They lasted from between one and five days, and only men were allowed to compete in the games. Many of the sports events were similar to those found in today's modern games where athletes run, jump and throw

The modern olympic games began with the creation of International Olympic Committee (IOC) in 1894 and Greece was the first country to hold the games, in the city of Athens, in 1896. Fourteen countries with 241 athletes competed in forty three events. Although some people wanted to have the games in Athens every four years, the IOC decided to have them in different countries and cities. In 1900 they were held in Paris and women were allowed to compete in the games for the first time. The first winter olympic games were held in 1924 and athletes competed in events such as skating and ice hockey. Over 200 countries now compete in the Summer Olympic Games. The number of events has increased to 300 events and instead of five days of competition, the games now last for seventeen days.

There are some problems, however, there were no olympic games held in 1916, 1940 and 1944 because of war. Also, some athletes use drugs to help them win. In addition, the games are very expensive. The 2014 winter games in Sochi for example, cost \$US50 billion. Nevertheles, the olympic games continue to be extremely popular all over the world.





The woolly mammoth is an extinct species of mammoth that lived during the Pleistocene until its extinct in the Holocene. It was one of the last line of mammoth. Its closest extant relatives is the Asian elephants. They are found roamed the cold tundra of Europe, Asia, and North America. The woolly mammoth was roughly the same size as modern African elephants. The woolly mammoth was well adopted to the cold environment during the last ice age. The habitat of woolly mammoth is known as mammoth steppe or tundra steppe.

It was covered in fur, with an outer covering of long guard hairs and a shorter door undercoat. The color of the coat varies from dark to light. The ears and tails are short to minimize frostbite and heat loss. It had long, curved tusks and four molars. The diet of woolly mammoth was mainly grasses and sedges. Male weighed up to 8.2 metric tons and female weighed up to 4 metric tons .A new born weighed about 90 kg. The appearance and behavior of this species are among the best studied of any prehistoric animal because of the discovery of frozen carcasses in Siberia and North America, as well as skeleton, teeth, dung and depiction from cave paintings. Environmental DNA and climatic change data suggest that vegetation scarcity led to the mass extinction of species.

BREAST CANCER

Breast cancer is an invasive cancer. The main cause of breast cancer is genetic mutation or damage to a person's DNA. Advances in screening and treatment for breast cancer have improved servival rates dramatically. Overall, the rate of breast cancer declined by about 40% trusted source between 1989 and 2017. A 2019 study showed, however, that the rate in the United states may no longer be declining in women aged 20-39 years.

Symptom:

The first symptom of breast cancer is usually an area of thickened tissue in the breast or lump in the breast or an armpit.

Other symptons include trusted source: Armpit or breast pain does not change with the monthly cycle pitting, like the surface of an orange, or color changes such as redness in the skin of the breast. A rash around or on one nipple. Discharge from a nipple, which maz contain blood. A sunken or inverted nipple. A change in the size or shape of the breast peeling, flaking, or scalling of the skin breast or nipple. After puberty, a female's breasts are made up of fat, connective tissues, and thousands of lobules. These are tiny glands that can produce milk. Tiny tubes, or ducts, carry the milk towards the nipple. Breast cancer develops as a result of genetic mutations or damage to DNA. These can be associated with trusted source exposure to estrogen, inherited genetic defects, or inherited genes that can cause cancer, such as the BRCA1 and BRCA2 genes.

Stages:

A doctor deteermines the stages of cancer according to the size of the tumor and whether it as spread to lymph nodes or other parts of the body.

Stage 0: This is also called ductal carcinoma in situ. The cancerous cells are only with in the ducts and have not spread to surrounding tissues.

Stage 1: At the stage, the tumor measures up to 2 centimetre's across. It has not affected any lymph nodes, or there are small groups cancers cells in lymph nodes.

Stage 2: The tumor is 2 cm across and has started to spread to nearby nodes, or the it is 2-5 cm across and has not spread to the lymph nodes.

Stage 3: The tumor is up to 5 cm across and has spread to several lymph nodes, or the tumor is larger than 5 cm and has spread to a few lymph nodes.

Stage 4: The cancer has spread to distant organs, most often the bones, liver, brain, or lungs.

<u>Treatment:</u> The main treatment options include: Radiation therapy, Surgery, Biological therapy, or targeted drug therapy, Hormone therapy, Chemotherapy.

CHANDRAYAANS

Source: With the launch of Chandrayaan -3, the Indian Space Research Organization (ISRO) is embarking to achieve a successful soft landing on the Moon. India aims to become the fourth country in the world to achieve this feat, joining the rank of the US, Russia and China.

About: Chandrayaan -3 is third lunar mission and second attempt at achieving a soft landing on the moon's surface. The mission took off from the Satish Dhawan Space Center (SDSC) in Srihari Kota It consists of an objective of developing and demonstrating new technologies required for interplanetary missions.

Mission objective of Chandrayaan -3: To demonstrate Safe and Soft Landing on Lunar Surface, To demonstrate Rover roving on the moon and To conduct in-situ science experiments.

Features: The lander (Vikram) and rover payloads (Pragyan) of Chandrayaan -3 remain the same as the Chandrayaan -2 mission. The scientific payloads on the lander aim to study various aspects of the lunar environment. these payloads include study lunar quakes, thermal properties of the lunar surface, changes in plasma near the surface, and accurately measuring the distance between Earth and the Moon. The propulsion module of Chandrayaan -3 feature a new experiment called Spectro-polarimetry of habitable by analyzing reflected light.

Launch and time line Launch on July 14, 2023 14:35:17 at the lunar dawn. (42 days) time. The lander and the rover will have a mission life of one lunar day (about 14 earth days) as they work on solar energy. The landing site for Chandrayaan -3 is near the lunar south pole. Landing site was named has Shiva Shakti Point. ISRO chairman is S. Somanath, the mission cost was Rs 721 crore.

Why on south pole Historically, spacecraft mission to the moon have primarily targeted the equatorial region due to its favorable terrain and operating conditions. Sunlight is scarce in certain polar regions. Temperature can reach -230 degree Celsius. Extreme and contrasting conditions that pose challenges for humans and deep space exploration.

Landing: Prime Minister Sri Narendra Modi declared August 23, 18:03 the Vikram lander landed on the moon, as National "Space Day".
